### DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE CITY OF MACEDONIA, OHIO

**WHEREAS**, as of the afternoon of March 17, there were 4 confirmed cases of individuals who have contracted COVID-19 in Summit County, and 88 confirmed cases in the State, and that number has since grown to at least 7 confirmed cases in Summit County and 119 confirmed cases in the State, meaning there are likely more unconfirmed cases that exist as a result of “community spread”; and

**WHEREAS**, as of March 20, 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic poses a real, present and significant threat to the safety and security of Macedonia residents, those who enter the City of Macedonia, as well as all citizens of the State of Ohio and of the United States; and


**WHEREAS**, the City has been in frequent contact with the Federal Coronavirus Task Force, the Center for Disease Control & Prevention, the State of Ohio Department of Health, Summit County Public Health, and numerous other local governmental agencies to monitor the status of the virus and take all steps necessary to protect the public health; and

**WHEREAS**, a State of Emergency has previously been declared on both a State and a Federal Level so as to enable governmental agencies to more effectively work together in planning and implementing a response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including Executive Order 2020-01D executed by Governor DeWine on March 9, 2020 which declares a State of Emergency generally for the State of Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, resources and capabilities of the City of Macedonia are being or are likely to be exhausted as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and the response thereto.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, City of Macedonia, Ohio Mayor Nicholas Molnar, through the powers vested in my Office as Mayor and Safety Director through the City’s Charter and Codified Ordinances, the Ohio Revised Code, applicable Acts, and the Constitution of the State of Ohio, do hereby order and declare a State of Public Health Emergency within in throughout the City of Macedonia, Ohio.

I hereby further order and declare that all municipal departments take all appropriate and necessary actions as directed by me and which are in the best interests of the City of Macedonia residents regarding the COVID-19 pandemic response until such time as this state of emergency ceases to exist. Such actions shall include, but are not limited, to assistance and coordination with other public agencies for the securing of state and federal funding and other emergency relief efforts to protect life and the public health.
