### LONGWOOD MANOR HISTORICAL SOCIETY (LMHS) MEETING June 28, 2022

The June 28, 2022, meeting of the LMHS was called to order at 10:04 AM, by President, Deb Mikulski. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**President's report** was given by Deb. LMHS is attempting a daytime meeting since most of the members are retired. She welcomed Mayor Nick Molar and Sam to today's meeting. The open house of 6/28 was canceled as no one was available to staff the Manor. Jason requested in the future that when we cancel an event to please notify him or Sam.

**Restroom/Flat roof repairs** were discussed. Estimates have been received by Barnes, M.R. Plank and Dun-Rite. Decision made to go with Dun-Rite. Deb will contact company. Jason reviewed process for city to pay. Jason will email information for LMHS to proof concerning awarding of the contract. He needs to verify that Dun-Rite is registered with the city. Proposals need to be submitted to John V. in finance. Dorothy requested to send thank-you to the other companies for submitting proposals.

**Chamber of Commerce** meeting on 6/9 was attended by Deb and Dorothy. Deb spoke about Longwood Manor. The guest speaker was David Allen. He is an author and creative marketing expert. He spoke about how to grow your business and is offering a free 30-minute ZOOM meeting to review your marketing presence. Deb and Dorothy will be participating in this in the future.

Vice-President Operations report was given by John. He reported he did some patching and caulking to decrease leaks. He plans to remove the door to the flat roof and replace it with paneling to increase access. He will then work on the door to see if he can repair it. The new refrigerator has been purchased and installed. Once Ian has completed the dining room ceiling then John will be evaluating the doors concerning replacing the thresholds. Deb will check with Ian as to when he will be completing project.

Minutes of the May 24, 2022, meeting were distributed. Motion made by Jan, seconded by John, and passed to accept.

**Treasurer's report** was given by Dorothy. Motion made by Jan, seconded by John, and passed to accept. Audit report is on hold currently as Joe (doing audit) is out of town. He has most of the information he needs except for this year's records, which were returned to Dorothy today. Balance 6/28/22 = \$2890.03

Barn report was given by Deb in absence of John C. He is working on building his committee and viewing other barns.

Parks and Recreation (P&R) report was given by Jason. Jason introduced Samantha (Sam) Edgar. She is the marketing and special events coordinator for the city. She is available to assist LMHS and will be taking a more active role with us to assist with marketing/advertising. The city has not needed to use the Manor for the summer recreation program. Mulch from the service department will not be available till around August. We can have mulch dumped when we will utilize it. Jason does not want to have mulch delivered and then it to sit. Some upcoming city events are: 8/11: Touch a Truck. Possibly a movie in the park in July. Deb asked about car show and there was no report. Person to contact did not respond. More events listed later in these minutes.

Mayor Molnar presented information. He stated that the new service department will not be built on Longwood grounds. The service center will be built on land by the current city hall. The P&R department will continue to utilize atleast one barn. He stated they will maintain the barns so they are safe for the city employees that are currently using

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them and not fall into disrepair. Nick reported that the quote to remove trees is about \$24,00.00. This has to be submitted to the finance committee and would be subcontracted out. The desk that was Mayor Long's has not been located and he is not sure what happened to it. Deb asked about Rotary assistance with Manor projects. Nick stated he would need to know exactly what would be needed and invited Deb to come to future Rotary meeting.
